

SHAUN M. SHEEHAN, DO, EMT-HP

EMERGENCY MEDICINE

Shaun M. Sheehan, DO, EMT-HP, the system's Emergency Department medical director; is a new position created to plan and coordinate services in the system's four Emergency Departments to ensure efficient and effective operations. As part of the Penn Highlands Healthcare leadership team, Sheehan will be responsible for developing and implementing the overall operating plans for emergency services for the system's four hospitals. More than 80,000 patients use the system's Emergency Departments on an annual basis.

Sheehan comes to Penn Highlands after serving as the medical director for the emergency room at UPMC Bedford Memorial Hospital, as well as being the assistant medical director of emergency medicine at UPMC Altoona. In addition to also working at both facilities as an emergency room physician at the same time as he served in these leadership roles, he also served as the director of emergency medical services at the Altoona facility.

Sheehan received his medical degree from the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine in Philadelphia and completed his emergency medicine residency at the Albert Einstein Medical Center, also in Philadelphia. He completed a fellowship in EMS and disaster medicine at Albert Einstein Medical Center.

He is board certified in emergency medicine by the American College of Emergency Physicians. He is a member of the American Medical Association, American College of Emergency Physicians and the American Osteopathic Association.
