OUTPATIENT SERVICES

Outpatient Behavioral Health Therapy

We provide patients with a variety of outpatient counseling, therapies and assessments for mild to severe behavioral health conditions. We offer psychiatric evaluation, medication management, psychological assessment and individual and family psychotherapy.

We offer these outpatient services for adults as well as children and adolescents in Brookville, Clearfield, Connellsville and DuBois.

Addiction Medicine

Addiction, or substance abuse disorder, is a treatable chronic medical disease involving complex interactions among brain circuits, genetics, the environment and an individual's life experiences. Addiction is the compulsive use of substances despite loss of money, relationships, family members, employment, freedom, health, dignity and even life. Throughout the United States, addiction impacts millions of lives including thousands in Pennsylvania.

Addiction medicine provides evidence-based prevention, evaluation, diagnosis treatment and medical management services for people struggling with unhealthy substance abuse.

INPATIENT SERVICES



Adult Inpatient Program

Our adult inpatient programs in Connellsville, DuBois, Huntingdon and Monongahela specialize in the treatment of emotional and behavioral difficulties experienced by individuals 18 years or older. These units operate 24/7 and feature both private and semi-private bedrooms as well as living, dining and recreational areas. Intensive psychotherapies, nursing and educational services aim to re-establish emotional and cognitive stability, enhance self-confidence, instill and reinforce coping capabilities and initiate a plan of post-hospital care to complete and sustain recovery.

Child and Adolescent Inpatient Program

Our child and adolescent inpatient program at the Stern Center for Behavioral Health in DuBois offers personalized care to young people age 5-18 who are exhibiting behavioral problems impairing their ability to function in the home and/or school. The unit operates 24/7 and has private rooms, a classroom, a dining room, a recreational lounge and therapy offices.

Patients are seen daily by a board-certified child and adolescent psychiatrist and members of our multidisciplinary treatment team. Classroom instruction with a certified special education teacher enables patients to keep up with their studies while hospitalized. Recreational activities are also integrated into the program on a daily basis.

Gerospychiatric Inpatient Program

Inpatient care for those age 55 and older is available in Brookville and Clearfield. Both locations feature a geropsychiatric inpatient unit specializing in the treatment of emotional and behavioral difficulties often experienced by individuals 55 years and older.

Services are offered in a calm and quiet homelike environment, while ensuring patients receive the highest quality care for both their medical and mental health needs. The program has a strong emphasis on wellness and therapeutic activities, ensuring patients receive the highest quality care for both their medical and mental health.

- Depression
- Schizophrenia
- Suicidal threats and/or actions

Referrals To Behavioral Health Services

The Psychiatric Admissions Department is available 24/7 to provide assessments by trained mental health staff for inpatient placement or can provide a referral for Outpatient services. Direct referrals can be made directly to the Psychiatric Admissions Department by Emergency Departments, County Crisis Agencies, and Case Managers, provided that sufficient clinical information is available. If admission is indicated, the referred patient must be medically cleared and admitted through an Emergency Department.
