COMMON TREATMENTS AND PROCEDURES INCLUDE:

- Hip/shoulder/elbow/knee/wrist/hand injections
- Minimally invasive lumbar decompression (MILD) for spinal stenosis
- Nerve blocks (with fluoroscopy or ultrasound), including but not limited to:
 - Lumbar/cervical/thoracic epidurals
 - Sacroiliac joint injections
 - Facet/medial branch blocks
 - Selective nerve root blocks/ tranforaminal epidurals
 - Caudal blocks
- Occipital/peripheral nerve block
- Radiofrequency procedures
- Spinal cord stimulation
- Sympathetic blocks
- Trigger point injections
- Vertiflex procedure for spinal stenosis
- Intracept procedure for low back pain
- Percutaneous tenotomy with Tenjet for tendinitis
- Ilovera cryoneurolysis for knee pain
- Platelet-rich plasma (PRP) injections
