The program has a strong emphasis on wellness, and therapeutic activities, ensuring patients receive the highest quality care for both their medical and mental health. Treatment is offered in a newly designed facility, offering a large amount of natural light, further enhancing the overall therapeutic experience.

CONDITIONS TREATED:

- Depression
- Suicidal threats and/or actions
- Acting out or dangerous behaviors
- Hallucinations and delusions
- Paranoia
- Schizophrenia
- Bipolar disorder
- Excessive fears and anxiety
- Confusion or mental status changes
- Behavioral disturbances, and problems associated with dementia

SERVICES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Psychiatric assessment and stabilization
- Medication evaluation, management and education
- Multidisciplinary treatment planning
- Coordination of care with other providers
- Psychological testing
- Exercise, nutrition and wellness education
- Leisure and recreational therapeutic activities
- Nutritional consultation
- Individual and group therapy
- 24 hour nursing care and support
- Diagnostic and laboratory testing
- Physical, occupational, respiratory and speech therapy as needed
- Family and patient education and support

CRITERIA INCLUDES, but is not limited to:

- Suicidal behaviors and threats
- Homicidal and/or assaultive behavior
- Confusion or mental status changes
- Eating or sleeping disturbances
- Severe agitation, anxiety or aggression
