One Pennsylvanian dies every 18 hours waiting for an organ transplant. Nationally, more than 121,000 people are awaiting an organ transplant. At least 21 will die each day without receiving one. Throughout April, CORE is encouraging individuals to register to become an organ, tissue and cornea donor. For every person who donates their organs, tissue and corneas, up to 50 lives can be saved or dramatically improved.

More than 8,500 patients in Pennsylvania are awaiting life-saving organ transplants. Thousands of others could benefit from life-enhancing tissue and cornea transplants.

More than 100,000 people across the U.S. are awaiting a kidney; 16,000 people across the nation are awaiting a liver.

Approximately 11,000 people die annually who are considered medically suitable to donate organs, tissue and corneas, yet only a fraction donate.
