More than 200,000 women are diagnosed with breast cancer each year in the U.S. The importance of early detection cannot be stressed enough. Size matters, and smaller tumors are less invasive and more treatable. Unfortunately, they are also harder to detect on self breast exams, which is why it is important for women to have regular, yearly mammograms.



PENN HIGHLANDS HEALTHCARE IS COMMITTED TO THE BATTLE AGAINST BREAST CANCER. We have new technology at Penn Highlands DuBois, Penn Highlands Elk and Penn Highlands Huntingdon, with more locations to come. **Tomosynthesis** – more commonly called 3-D mammography – is now available. Using the same X-ray technology as traditional 2-D mammography, the procedure feels essentially the same for the patient. The difference is the image clarity for the radiologist who reads the mammogram. Whereas 2-D mammograms give views only from the front and side of the breast, 3-D mammograms provide images of the breast in “slices” from many different angles.

“This technology is especially beneficial for women with dense breast tissue,” explained Dr. Kelley Smith, general surgeon with a focus on breast surgery at Penn Highlands DuBois. “Women at a higher risk for developing breast cancer may also benefit from 3-D mammography.”

Two-dimensional mammography is still a gold standard and is indicated for routine screenings. It is an excellent tool for detecting breast abnormalities.
